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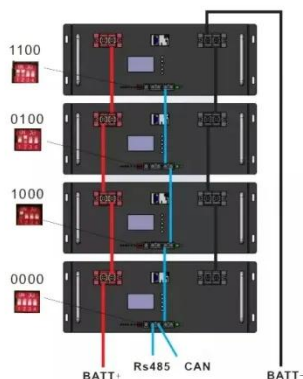


Myanmar's military prioritizes its own survival in earthquake response
