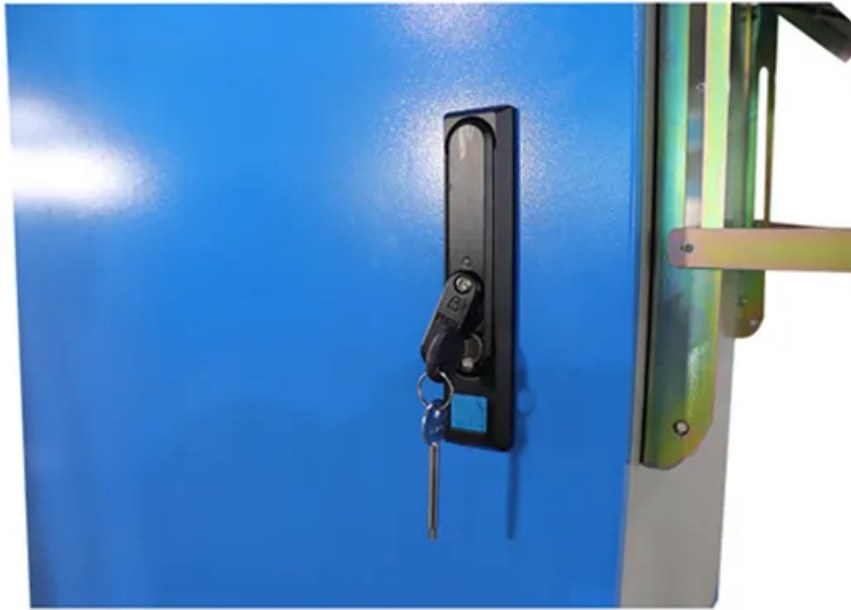


Malawi australia solar power



Overview

The falling cost of solar power is bringing electricity within reach for low-income households. In communities far from the national grid, where affordability is also a major concern, off-grid solutions are essential for rapidly expanding access. In Malawi, only 23% of the population has access to. Traditional Authority Kasakula – one of the poorest and most underserved communities in one of Africa's least electrified nations, will today, 26th August 2025, become the first community in Malawi to achieve 100% access to solar power through a ground-breaking Energy-as-a-Service model.

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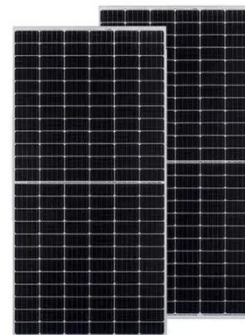

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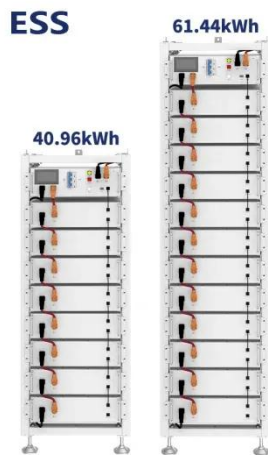
