The baseband processor converts signals to digital form. A duplexer lets one antenna transmit and receive at once. A control unit manages power, channels, and timing. They transmit. The idea of base stations is anchored in their function to provide coverage, capacity, and connectivity, hence allowing for extending the working capabilities of mobile phones and other radio gear. It is sometimes called a cell tower. It enables seamless communication by linking various wireless devices to broader networks, ensuring that data flows efficiently from one point to another.
