The fingers are ultra-thin, metallic lines — often made from silver or aluminum — spread across the surface of each solar cell. The grid lines are essential for the panels to generate usable electricity, and without them, your panel would be little more than a glorified sunlight. 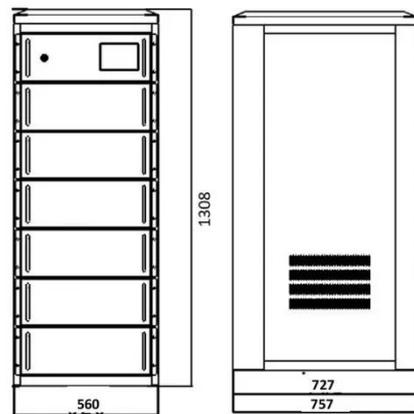
