

Can solar panels be installed on public roofs

By 2026: All new public and commercial buildings over a certain size (e.g. with usable floor area above 250 m²;) must have solar panels installed on their roofs.

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Installing solar arrays on municipal roofs is the most visible way to set an example, but where on-site solar is not feasible, cities can still use of-site solar power to accomplish their goals.

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
