I mounted my 180w pv panel to the 12" high side wall of my aluminum framed full roof rack with a stainless steel piano hinge so it could be propped up at an optimum angle when needed.

I think you'll be going into the side of the frame and not the bottom. If so I'd come up about 1/2" from the bottom of the frame and send it. Use short self tappers so you don't hit the back ...
