Value-added tax rebates on 249 exported products, including photovoltaic cells, will be withdrawn starting from April 1, the Ministry of Finance and the State Taxation Administration jointly announced on Jan. 9.

The Chinese Ministry of Finance and the State Administration of Taxation have revealed that the country will reduce the export tax rebate for 209 products, including solar PV cells and modules from 13% to ...

Starting 1 April 2026, the value-added tax (VAT) export rebate for PV products and other items will be removed. The specific list of products is set out in a separate document.

On November 15, China's Ministry of Finance and the State Administration of Taxation announced a reduction in the export tax rebate rate for certain products, including refined oil, photovoltaic ...

In a joint statement issued by the Ministry of Finance and the State Taxation Administration, it was revealed that the export tax rebate rate for photovoltaic products, along with batteries and certain non ...

China reduced its solar export tax rebate from 13% to 9% in December 2024, with industry sources indicating further cuts to 3-5% or complete elimination by January 2026.

Products such as refined oils, photovoltaic products, and batteries now have a reduced rebate rate of 9%, down from the previous 13%. This change reflects China's commitment to sustainability and its ...

Meanwhile, the export tax rebate rate for some refined oil products, photovoltaic products, batteries and certain non-metallic mineral products will be reduced from 13 percent to 9 percent.
